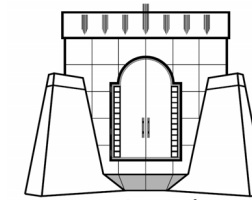

- (33:12-23) Moses pleads to be able to see God, but that request is denied, for a human may not see Me and live. God does promise that Moses will be able to see His "back," i.e., have an indirect manifestation of His presence.
- (34:1-9) Moses returns to Mt. Sinai for the third time and receives the revelation concerning God's Thirteen Attributes.
- (34:10-26) The renewal of the covenant between God and Israel, with further instructions concerning the keeping of the mitzvot.
- (34:27-28) After 40 days, Moses receives the second set of Tablets.

Over many years, I have had the opportunity to work with Rabbi Pressman and discuss aspects of leadership and governance with him. Through the years, he has taught me some key lessons in organizational leadership.

- Do not ascribe to malevolence that which can be explained by incompetence.
- It is management's role to make sensible exceptions to policy.
- Beware the Law of Unintended Consequences.

In Parshat Ki Thissa, we will see these leadership lessons played out in different ways.

The Lord of Hosts: Yahweh as a War God

Dr. Jonathan Roth, Professor of History, San Jose State University, will discuss the Biblical term "Lord of Hosts", which comes from the Hebrew term "Yahweh Tzaba'ot". In early books of the Bible, God often functions as a general, directing the Children of Israel in wars. After the fall of the kingdoms of Israel and Judah, Jews frequently served in the armies of surrounding nations. Worship of the "Lord of Hosts" might have played an important role in the survival of Judaism in exile. Dr. Roth will show how war played a much larger role in early Judaism than is often recognized.
